LIMITED WARRANTY

Tualatin Sleep Products warrants that this product will be free from defects in material and workmanship as described in this warranty (hereinafter referred to as the "Limited Warranty").

LENGTH AND CONDITIONS OF THE LIMITED WARRANTY

This Limited Warranty starts on the date of purchase.

REMOVAL OF LAW LABEL VOIDS THIS WARRANTY. STAINS ON THE MATTRESS COVER VOIDS THIS WARRANTY.

To determine the length of this warranty, refer to the product's "Law Label" letter and/or numbers and the corresponding warranty period listed herein.

If a defect that is covered during the warranty period occurs, Tualatin Sleep Products will repair or replace (at the factory's option) the defective mattress and/or box spring. If replacement is required, Tualatin Sleep Products may substitute materials of equal or higher quality if the like components are not available.

The Limited Warranty is valid only under the following circumstances:

- You must be the original purchaser from an authorized dealer (in the United States.)
- You must provide a copy of the original store purchase receipt, proof of purchase date, purchase price and law tag.
 You must provide transportation or accept freight charges
- You must provide transportation or accept freight charges to and from the nearest factory, to either return the product for repair or for replacement of the product.

The Limited Warranty does not cover the following:

- 1. The mattress or box spring fabric cover.
- 2. Slight body impressions (less than 11/2").
- Certain smooth top mattresses have a reduced tolerance for body impressions. If body impressions exceed ¾" on these models the product can be serviced as a warranty.
- 4. Bent border wire due to mishandling.
- Handles are not covered. Mattress handles are only for positioning the mattress and are not designed to support the full weight of the mattress.
- 6. Comfort preference.
- Sheet fit (Tualatin Sleep Products does not warrant that the mattress will fit a particular sheet size.)
- 8. Transportation charges.
- 9. Abuse.
- 10. Damage caused when bed is not adequately supported. (See back panel under Important Care Instructions.)
- 11. Bed height.
- 12. Bedding sold "as is".

Tualatin Sleep Products reserves the right to refuse service and invalidate this Limited Warranty when, upon inspection, the product (mattress or foundation) is found to be in unsanitary condition, soiled, or when product failure is due to causes other than defective material and/or workmanship.

This mattress is designed for full performance when used with a matching foundation as a total sleep system. If used on a faulty foundation, resulting mattress damage will void your warranty.

Never-Flip™ mattresses are built with one sided sleeping surfaces. You will never have to flip your mattress. You will need to rotate the mattress as outlined in our Care Instructions.

BODY IMPRESSIONS

Your mattress has been constructed with the finest materials. It is designed to conform to a person's individual contour. Your sleeping position may result in "body impressions." This is normal and not a structural defect but merely the localized compacting of upholstery materials (refer to Care Instructions.)

SEVERE IMPRESSIONS are body impressions which exceed 1½" in depth below the normal level of the product. *Warranty Code AE allows for a 1" or greater impression for the first year (from original purchase). Remaining 14 years of warranty allows for 1½" impressions Sovere impressions are covered by this I imited Warranty.

- 4. Use a quality bed frame. To avoid structural damage and voiding of your warranty, queen and king size sets must also be used with a rigid center support with legs.
- 5. Do not get the mattress wet.
- 6. Use a mattress pad.
- 7. If you purchased a mattress only, it must be supported by a quality comparable foundation.
- 8. Do not use an iron or apply excessive heat to the mattress.

NEVER - FLIPTM: Mattresses never have to be flipped but need to be rotated. (Follow the 1st, 2nd & 5th illustration boxes above).


Push at opposite corners A and B while mattress is lying flat.


Position mattress across bed so that it hangs over a foot or more.
